

The Ohio Treasurer of State Custody Consulting RFI Questions and Answers

Q: In order to respond to this Request for Information (“RFI”), does a Respondent need to individually request a copy of the RFI from the Treasurer’s Office or may a Respondent respond to the RFI if they were forwarded the RFI from a third-party requestor?

A: A Respondent is not required to request the RFI from the Treasurer’s Office and may receive the RFI from a third-party requestor. However, the Treasurer’s Office would prefer that all Respondents and interested potential Respondents request the RFI directly from the Treasurer’s Office for the purpose of tracking RFI requests.
